A decade ago, the European Fund of the Balkans (EFB) was set up to strengthen democracy, foster European integration and affirm the role of the Western Balkans in addressing Europe's emerging challenges. As a joint initiative of European foundations, the EFB was designed to bring the Western Balkans closer to the EU and bring the EU closer to the Western Balkans.

The EFB invested Ten years in:



Developing human capital, because the most competent people need to influence the political, economic and cultural development of society. By upgrading people's knowledge and experience, and by connecting these individuals, the EFB has built a strong community capable of changing the region's present and future.



Increasing CSO policy impact, because region-related policies need to be influenced by regionally connected citizens. Through establishing platforms for tighter networking of the Western Balkan think tanks and activist organizations, the EFB has provided a chance for citizens to jointly define responses to the most important challenges faced by the region, and to influence the decisions of Balkan and European officials.



Building the capacities of think tanks, because creating good policies based on public interest is a fundamental condition of democratic transformation. In order to improve evidence-based policy-making processes, the EFB has developed the research, analytical and advocacy capacities of the Balkan's think tanks.



Advocating EU integration and regional cooperation, because Europeanization of the Balkans and stronger regional cooperation is an objective that can be achieved only with a high level of public support. Through expert insight, broad social dialogue and cutting-edge initiatives, the European Fund for the Balkans has pointed out the issues that accompany political, economic and social transformation in the region, and has advocated long-term, applicable and innovative solutions.
